### REGISTRATION OF NEW STUDENTS

**All new families are to register their child(ren) online via PowerSchool Registration which is available on the Black Gold School Division website at: [New Student Registration](#)**

The school office will open for processing of new registrations and appointments starting on Thursday, August 26, 2021. In August, the school will send a confirmation to parents that their registration has been accepted.

Students who were registered in Black Gold School Division in 2020-2021 and are returning to a Black Gold School in 2021-2022, should NOT complete a new student registration form. Instead, they could complete an online Student Enrolment Verification Form, through their [PowerSchool Parent Portal](#). The form will be available prior to August 30, 2021

### RETURNING STUDENTS - VERIFICATION FORM

**Students who were attending a Black Gold School Division (BGSD) school in 2020-2021 and are returning to a BGSD school in 2021-2022 are automatically registered for the 2021-2022 school year.**

**All BGSD families are expected to complete the Student Enrollment Verification Form for the 2021-2022 school year. In late August, parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger with details on how to access this form during the first week of school.**

### CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDING IN-SCHOOL CLASSES OR DISTANCE LEARNING

**On August 3, 2021, all parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger to confirm the choice**

of learning for each child. If the parents/guardians wish to change the choice of learning, instructions on how to do this will be included. All change requests must be submitted by August 13, 2021.

## EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES (ECS): KINDERGARTEN & PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS

### **KINDERGARTEN:**

For 2021-2022, we will offer **French Immersion Morning and Afternoon Kindergarten** and **English Morning and Afternoon Kindergarten**.

Morning Classes: 8:35 – 11:26

Afternoon Class: 12:21 – 15:12

Staggered Entry – August 30, 31, & September 1 2021.

First day of Kindergarten: September 2, 2021

**No school for Kindergarten on the first Wednesday of each month from October to June.**

Class Placement

ECS placement letters for students have already been sent home. The placement letter included your child's staggered entry date and supply list. Please note that Kindergarten students do not ride the bus on staggered entry days.

### **PRE-KINDERGARTEN:**

Pre-kindergarten is offered at École Bellevue School, East Elementary School, Linsford Park School, Calmar Elementary School, Thorsby Elementary School and Robina Baker Elementary School. Only children who qualify for ECS programming due to a delay or diagnosis as per Alberta Education criteria are eligible. Please contact Niki Gill at [niki.gill@blackgold.ca](mailto:niki.gill@blackgold.ca) to inquire about eligibility.

To ensure a balance of strengths and needs across all programs, program times will be communicated directly by the school to all eligible families in September once school staff have had the opportunity to meet all the children in person and perform any necessary assessments.
